

Painful wait for CAT candidates

Bangalore: Their year of hard work has gone down the drain. At least, it seems like that. With no communication for many CAT candidates from Prometric on re-scheduled dates, students are apprehensive and worried whether they will write CAT 2009 at all.

Prometric recently released a statement saying it

will give an opportunity for students who couldn't take the test. But nothing has happened so far.

Students whom TOI spoke with are upset over the way the entire CAT 2009 was handled.

"Prometric did not take CAT seriously. It didn't realize how important CAT is for Indians. They handled CAT like the way they handled



GMAT," CAT takers said. For those who couldn't take the test, it's a long wait as they haven't received any com-

munication. Anurag Bharat, a student from Delhi, was supposed to appear on December 1 but was cancelled due to technical snag. "I am trying to get Prometric but I am unable to reach them. There is no information on my rescheduled

date as of now. I don't know whether I will write CAT or not," he said.

Ditto with Monica Rajora, a student. She was supposed to appear for CAT on November 28 but was cancelled.

"I didn't receive any information from Prometric. People at the test centres said Prometric would contact me with a rescheduled date in 15 days," she added.
